<u>Face masks</u> and <u>social distancing</u> rules are still in place for our monthly meetings during the winter months.

Good News for SuperGold Card Holders

Environment Canterbury (ECan) has voted to change the rules of their free bus service for SuperGold Card holders. Currently free bus service is available starting after 9am, stopping between 3:00pm and 6:30pm, and then starting again after 6:30pm. ECan has now approved a resolution to extend free travel for SuperGold Card holders, to include all travel after 9am.

There are also some other changes to bus fares. From February 2023 Community Services Card holders, those aged under 25, tertiary students and Total Mobility card holders will pay a \$1 flat fare, and all other customers a \$2 flat fare.

ECan Chairperson Jenny Hughey said that "It is a balancing act. We have kept social equity at the forefront, through agreeing on a new public transport fare structure and finding ways to reduce the rates increase as much as possible, while not taking our eye off the huge task ahead of us in the region".

Sue Johnson grew up in Blackpool, England. She trained and worked as a nurse in Liverpool in a paediatric intensive care unit. She later moved to New Zealand in 1984, and in 1993 gained a Bachelor of Laws with first class honours from the University of Canterbury.

She has worked as a solicitor doing civil litigation and medical law. In 2007 she was appointed as a coroner. All coroners in New Zealand must be barristers and solicitors of the High Court. Sue finds her background in nursing extremely helpful in her role as coroner.
