10:00 Speaker: Mark Soltero Art Historian

Mark was born in San Francisco and attended Art School where he met his wife, the New Zealand artist Kim Hennessy. They moved to NZ in 1995 and have raised two sons in Governors Bay.

Mark's practice contains a number of seemingly disparate threads from Typography and Camouflage to Architecture and Cinema interiors. For the past decade Mark's work has been largely monochromatic but recently, beginning with the use of Silver and Gold, the work has begun to return to his earlier practice with colour.

Mark is also a member of the collective Art Associates Aotearoa. He has given public presentations on his practice at Dunedin School of Art, Ara Institute of Canterbury and the Christchurch Art Gallery. He holds an MFA from Dunedin School of Art and is represented by Artfull Online, Chambers Art Gallery Christchurch and McAtamney Gallery Geraldine.
