Our September Speaker

Olivia Taylor

Olivia moved to Christchurch to study Politics and Psychology and developed a strong passion for local government during this time.

After graduating, she worked in the Engagement Team for Christchurch City Council – who make sure community views and preferences are considered when decisions are made.

She is now the Waste Minimisation Advisor, which means she gets to talk to people in the community and work with the communications team – making sure residents get the right information about what they can put in their bins.

About her talk

The Resource Recovery Team provides information on what goes in which bin and why, alternative recycling schemes, and waste minimisation tips.

The Team is here to answer your queries about where our recycling goes, what the Council is doing to reduce waste, and what is happening on a national scale in New Zealand to address this issue.

- **Kerbside collection basics:** What goes in the recycling, refuse, and organics bins, and why it's important to get it right.
- Common materials that can't be recycled: A clear explanation of why certain items are not recyclable and the impact this has on our recycling systems.
- What happens to your waste: Insight into the journey of waste from collection to disposal and the sustainability efforts behind it.
- **Alternative solutions:** Guidance on how to manage items that can't be disposed of through the kerbside bins, and alternative disposal options.

Olivia would be happy to answer any questions you have about items which you are not sure how to dispose of, from dead possums to polystyrene. If you have any examples please bring them with you (but no dead possums please!)




Showbiz Christchurch Offer
